? Why Do We Have This Policy?

10 Our Rules – What You Need to Know:

- ✓ The BEST thing to do is to:
 - ♣ Leave your phone at Home!
- ✓ If you have not left your phone at Home, then when you arrive:
 - ♣ Please hand your phone in to a member of staff

 - ♣ Your phone will be given back at the end of the day
 - ♣ You can use it once you've left MIAG

What If I Need My Phone?

If there's an emergency or you need to contact home:

- Just ask a staff member we're always happy to help
- ♣ We can support you if you feel anxious about being without your phone

▲ If You Don't Follow the Rules:

- ♣ Staff will remind you of the policy
- ♣ Your phone may be kept by staff until the end of the day
- ♣ Repeated issues may mean a meeting with parents/carers

But remember – we're here to support, not punish

○ Why It's Important?

- ♣ Phones can be a distraction from learning
- ♣ They can cause anxiety, conflict, or upset if used in the wrong way
- We want MIAG to be a safe, calm and focused place for everyone
