? Why Do We Have This Policy?

We want MIAG to be:

- ✚ A place where everyone can **learn, feel safe, and focus**

Phones can get in the way of that. So, we have some simple rules to help.

🚫 Our Rules – What You Need to Know:

✅ The BEST thing to do is to:

- ✚ Leave your phone at **Home!**

✅ If you have not left your phone at Home, then when you arrive:

- ✚ Please hand your phone in to a member of staff
- ✚ It will be kept **safe and secure** for the day
- ✚

✅ Going home:

- ✚ Your phone will be given back at the end of the day
 - ✚ You can use it once you’ve left MIAG
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💭 What If I Need My Phone?

If there’s an emergency or you need to contact home:

- ✚ Just **ask a staff member** – we’re always happy to help
- ✚ We can support you if you feel anxious about being without your phone

⚠️ If You Don't Follow the Rules:

- ✚ Staff will remind you of the policy
- ✚ Your phone may be kept by staff until the end of the day
- ✚ Repeated issues may mean a meeting with parents/carers

But remember – we're here to support, not punish

 - ✚ They can cause anxiety, conflict, or upset if used in the wrong way
